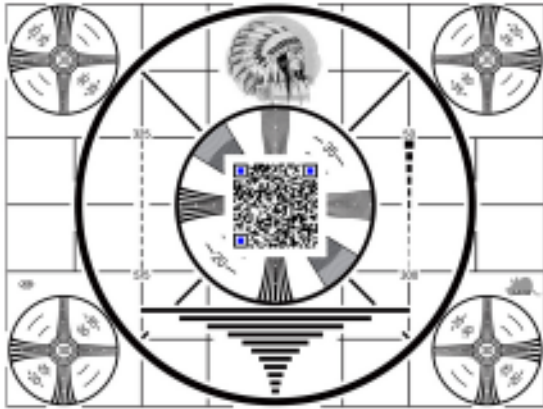


“QR Circus” on display at “Hotel Lunar Lowell: Explorations in Atomicpunk” Art exhibit



SEATTLE - Seattle artist Jerry Whiting has 2 pieces from his “QR Circus” collection on display at the Hotel Lunar Lowell: Explorations in Atomicpunk exhibit opening June 18, 2011 in Everett WA. The “QR Circus” is a body of work incorporating QR barcodes and smartphones into the creative process.

The Explorations in Atomicpunk exhibit is Lowell Art Works' 3rd Annual Sci-Fi Spectacular and features “art that celebrates science fiction, the atomic age, atomicpunk, steampunk, fantasy tech, radioactive monsters, and the optimistic aesthetic of mid-century design.” Two of Jerry's digital prints, “Sputnik” and “Test Pattern”, are in this juried show.

Six pieces from the “QR Circus” (including “Test Pattern”) hung in the “Access Point” exhibit at RockIDement Visual Studio in Seattle April-May 2011 rockdement.com/exhibitions/2011/11_04.html.
